The Português of D. Manuel I (10 cruzados)

Is a singular coin in Portuguese numismatics for its political, economic and propagandistic significance. Of great historical and numismatic symbolism, the **Português** was highly prized for weight and fine alloy, and for nearly seventy years was the largest gold coin struck by

any European country. Its legend signaled power, listing the monarch's titles and possessions. It enjoyed such acceptance that several cities and principalities in northern Europe – Hamburg, Lübeck, Schleswig-Holstein, Magdeburg, Zwolle and Denmark – began minting coins to

the same module and weight, bearing the Cross of the Order of Christ and, in some cases, stating: "According to the fair weight and alloy of the coin of Portugal." These are the **Portugalöser** issues.

João VI, of which only 3 examples are known, present in the collections of the Bank of Portugal, Millennium BCP, and Novo Banco.

OTHER HIGHLIGHTS

- Of great note are auctions 100 - Óis Collection, 103 - Algarve II Collection, and finally the best collection we sold in 41 years, Porto Vintage Collection, 2015-2016, in 3 auctions, 104, 106, and 108 – about 4,500 coins, 1,200 gold in a total of 2,159 lots, and we will hold on April 27, 2017, an interesting collection, Madeira Island from a dear friend and client since 1976.
- In June 2017, the Important Lezírias Auction and in October with high-quality gold coins, the Galaico-Duriense Auction.
- Numisma continued with 9 auctions from 113 to 121, from April 27, 2018, to December 11, 2019, with fantastic collections with very rare gold coins and medals and an excellent collection of hammered silver and billon coins and many other coins from Portugal and around the world, as well as banknotes and numismatic books.
- Namely the Caldas da Rainha, Vista Hermosa, Príncipe Real, Fado (3 auctions), Silves, Sagres, and Oliveira collections.
- To celebrate the 44th anniversary, in 2020, we held auctions of the Abrantes, Bragança, DADAO collections and ended with the OLÉ collection.
- Numisma founded in 1976, to celebrate in 2021, “Numisma 45 years” held two auctions in the first semester, Maravilha I and Maravilha II, and in the first half of the second semester presented the Quilómetro Collection.





20 FANTASTIC LOTS

SOME OF THE FINEST PIECES AUCTIONED (2015-2019).

Between 2015 and 2019, **Numisma Auctions** held four memorable sales that highlighted **20 fantastic lots** – true jewels of Portuguese and Brazilian numismatics – distributed across the **Porto Vintage I, II, III, and Silves collections**. These events attracted collectors and investors for the rarity, quality, and historical value of the pieces, achieving impressive hammer prices that reflect their exclusivity and state of preservation.

In **Auction #104 – Porto Vintage I Collection** (2015), nine extraordinary lots were presented. Among them, the standout was **D. João V – Peça 1727 B** (Lot 218), an extremely rare gold coin in superb condition, which sold for €82,000; and **D. Filipe I – 500 Reais** (Lot 117), of the highest rarity with a closed crown, which realized €75,000. Other notable pieces included the **Dobra 1730 B** (Lot 197) at €61,000 and the **gold bar of the “Serro Frio” Foundry House** of the Brazilian Empire (Lot 599), which achieved an impressive €84,000, reflecting the fascination with colonial pieces in superb condition.

Auction #106 – Porto Vintage II Collection (2016) brought three notable lots. The **D. João V – Peça 1728 B** (Lot 233), also extremely rare and in superb condition, sold for €70,000; while the **Dobra 1730 B** (Lot 222) reached €46,000; and the **4 Cruzados 1642 of D. Afonso VI** (Lot 188) closed at €50,000 – underscoring the consistency of the reign of D. João V as one of the most highly valued among collectors.

In **Auction #108 – Porto Vintage III Collection** (2016), five lots stole the show. The **D. Fernando I – Dobra Pé Terra** (Lot 276), extremely rare and nearly superb, achieved the highest price of this collection, €85,000. Other notable pieces included the **Português of D. João III** (Lot 345), superb and extremely rare, which sold for €75,000; and the India – **D. João III –**

Escudo de S. Tomé (Lot 704), which realized €65,000 – showing the geographic and historical diversity of the coins auctioned.

Finally, **Auction #119 – Silves Collection** (2019) presented three exceptional lots. The **D. João II – Justo** (Lot 12), extremely rare, sold for €72,500; the **D. Fernando I – Gentil** (Lot 11) achieved €50,000; and the **D. Henrique I – 500 Reais** (Lot 15), although the least valued of the 20 lots, still impressed at €30,000 – demonstrating the continued strength of medieval and Renaissance numismatics.

These **20 lots**, distributed among the four auctions, reached final values **exceeding €1.1 million**, with gold coins ranging from the reign of D. Fernando I (14th century) to the Brazilian Empire, passing through historically significant periods such as the reigns of D. João V and D. Pedro II. The combination of rarity, states of preservation described as “superb,” “fine,” or “VF+,” and the provenance of the Porto Vintage and Silves collections consolidated **Numisma Auctions’** reputation as a reference in the numismatic market, offering pieces that are true treasures of the Lusophone monetary heritage. ●

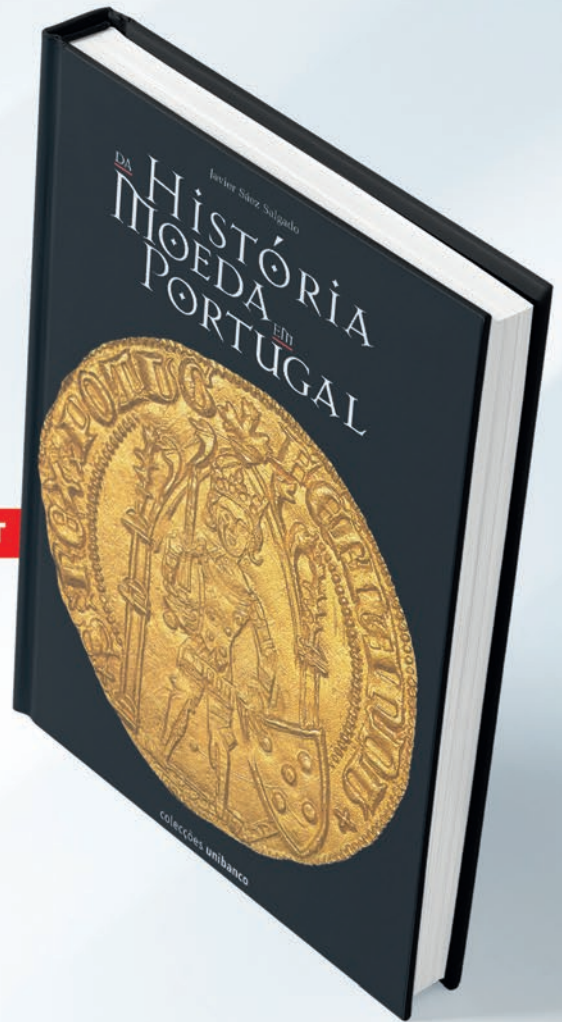

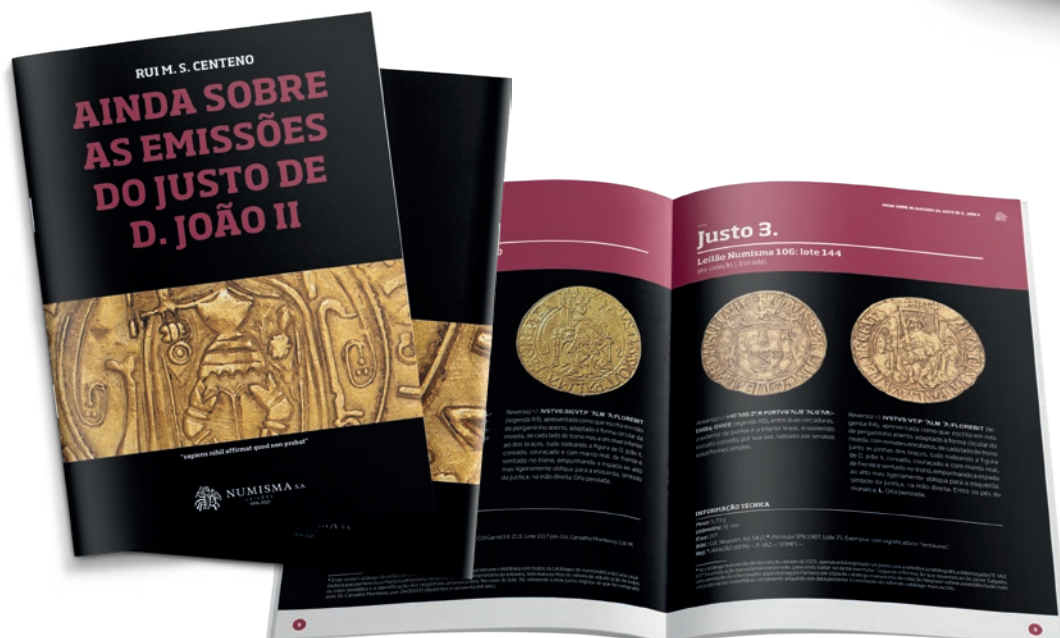
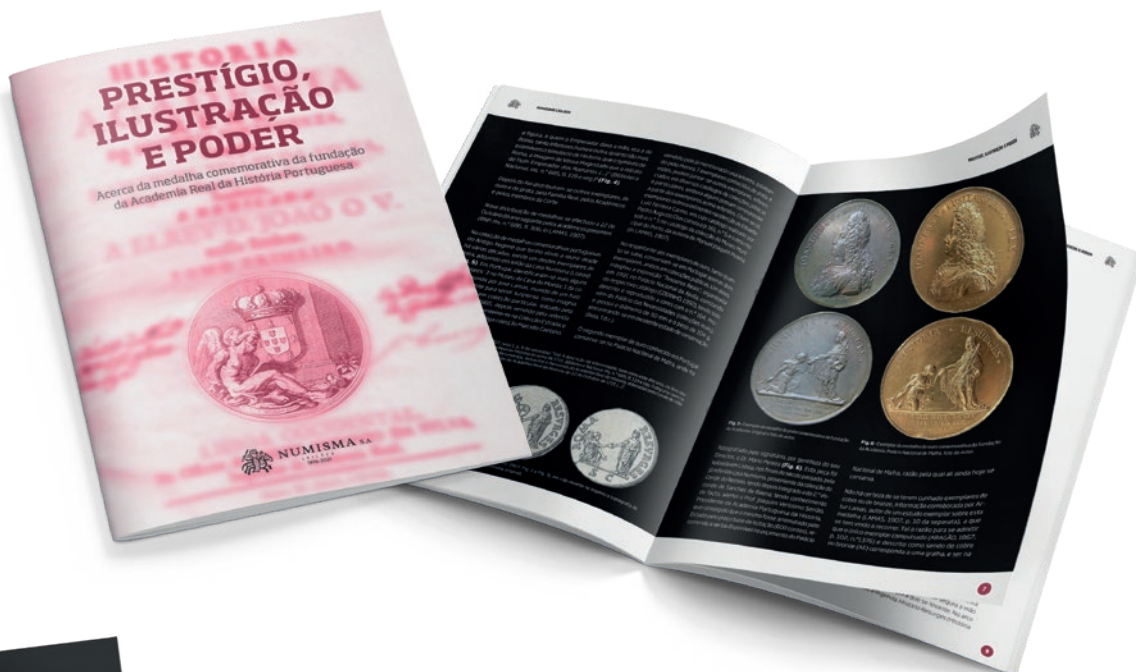
